Soles4Souls, based in Nashville, Tennessee, disrupts the cycle of poverty by creating jobs and providing relief through the distribution of shoes and clothing around the world. During the month of April 2018, Cedarfield residents and team members donated unwanted shoes. For seven days of the month, there was a fundraising competition with all proceeds benefiting Soles4Souls. Twelve team members decorated a Converse sneaker to reflect their personality or role at Cedarfield. Community members were asked to vote for their favorite shoe by making a donation. One penny equaled 1 vote. The higher the monetary amount, the more votes the shoe received. Over \$600 was raised and over 700 shoes were donated. With Soles4Souls partners in Haiti and Honduras, Cedarfield has given the gift of 3,500 meals, one year of enrollment tuition for 23 students or 35 years worth of shelter for a family.



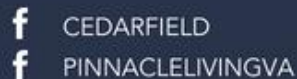

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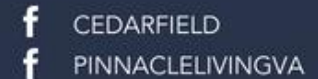
