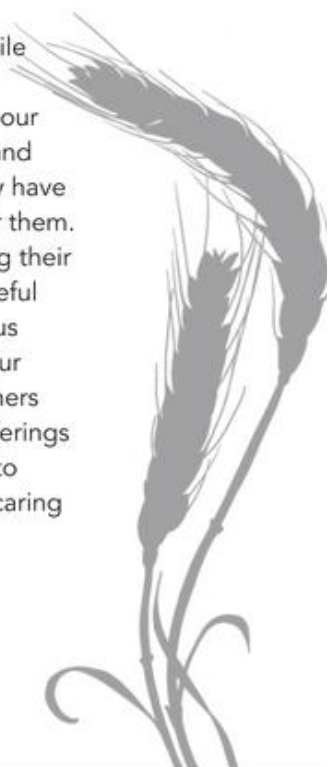
MOTHER'S DAY

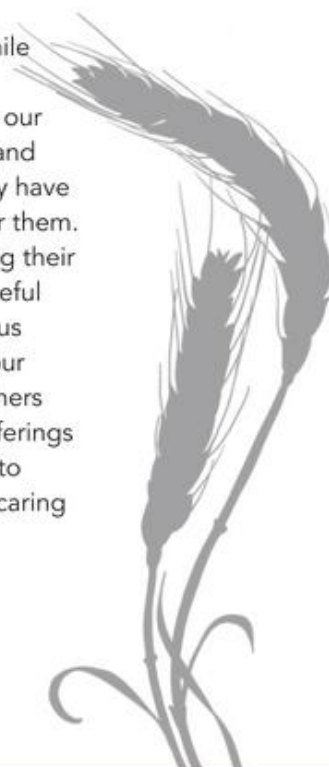
MOTHER'S DAY
